Edge Outreach sells the shoes to an exporter who distributes the shoes at a very low cost to small businesses in developing countries where the owners are working to provide for their families. If the shoes are worn out and not reusable, they get sold for recycling and end up in gym floors or outdoor tracks. This money is then used by Edge Outreach to train, equip and mobilize willing volunteers to install a unique water purification system in communities that have never tasted a pure healthy glass of water.
